## **KOA Interactive Lesson Schedule: Week Beginning Monday June 22nd**

Many thanks to all the students that have attended the Y10 interactive lessons last week. These have been a real success with student feedback including;

"I think interactive lessons are good because they really help me to understand the subject in a lot more detail than just work online or on paper and also I could ask my teachers questions about the work without having to email them."

Benefits of attending have included stronger understanding as a result of the teacher explanation, the opportunity to ask questions, the chance to hear your own teachers voice, and greater confidence in being able to complete follow on learning.

Teachers have loved the opportunity to interact directly with students, re-connecting with them and beginning to re-build the strong relationships that we know are a corner-stone of great learning.

We recognise there were teething problems last week. Many thanks for all of your feedback. We hope next week will be smoother, with the timetable now split into specific 30 minute sessions.

These lessons are for all of our Y10 students. You will notice that there are repeated subject sessions through the week. This is to enable students within the KOA bubbles to access the lessons, and to ensure that group sizes are not too big. This allows greater teacher interaction with individual students. In order for students to plan their time through the week, staff have been asked to notify students, via INSIGHTS, of which group they are in for the subjects where there are repeated sessions.

On Monday, students will be sent messages, via both INSIGHTS and their KOA email, of any pre-lesson reading / activity, the day and time of their specific interactive lessons through the week and a link to access each lesson. At the time of the lesson, students should click on the link to access the interactive lesson. Students should have pen and paper available as they may be asked / want to make notes of the teacher input. The lessons are automatically recorded. If a student misses a lesson, or would like to re-watch the lesson afterwards, they simply need to click on the original link.
