

Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing in relation to COVID-19 and possible plans to close the academy.

We currently have **no** reported cases of any pupil or staff member diagnosed with COVID-19 in our school. We are continuing to follow the advice of the UK Government and Public Health England and will not close unless told to.

The government advises that those suffering with a persistent cough and/or a fever should stay at home for 7 days. This may mean your child having to miss school; please contact the Academy on the first day of absence. The government is **not** requesting whole households to self-isolate if one member has a persistent cough or a fever. If this advice changes we will update you.

We understand that you may be worried about the impact of a possible school closure on your child's learning, particularly if they are due to sit exams this summer. In the event of being told to close, the academy will be ensuring pupils can access learning via a mix of paper and online resources including the following websites:
